1. How would you react if you were face-to-face with your celebrity of choice?
2. When we talk about God's glory, what do you think "glory" means?
 - a. Last week's definition of glory - The immense weight, or worthiness of God's character, combined with His awesomeness, splendor, and majesty.
3. What does it mean that Jesus is the incarnation of God?
4. Read John 10:10-14. John says "the world" did not know Jesus, did not accept Him. If Jesus was the incarnation of God, why do you think the world did not recognize or receive Him?
5. Why do you think the world does not recognize or receive Him today? What are some of the roadblocks in the way of people being able to identify and accept Jesus?
6. Read Hebrews 1:1-3. How should we respond to Jesus being the radiance of God's glory?
7. Consider the disciples being around Jesus. Do you know anyone who is "full of grace and truth" all of the time? What would it be like to spend your days with someone who was always forgiving, gracious, and honest ALL the time?
8. Read John 17:1-5. Imagine being one of the disciples listening to Jesus' prayer. What would be some of the thoughts and feelings you would be having?
9. Do you know Jesus with the depth that allows you see His glory in your life? Or, are you merely going through the motions? Do you find yourself distant from the brilliance of God?
10. What steps can you take to make sure that just like the disciples, you are close enough to Jesus to see His glory? What does this look like in a modern-day context?
