NEW TESTAMENT READING PLAN QUESTIONS:

- What impacted you as you read through the Bible reading this past week?
- In teaching about humility, Jesus told his disciples in Luke 14:8 that when they “are invited by someone to a wedding banquet, don’t recline at the best place.” They were to take the lowest place. How do we apply this truth to our lives today? Why does Jesus tell them to do this?
- Luke 15 includes some of these most well-known stories in the Bible. What do these verses tell us about the heart of Jesus? Do you think the church has this same heart today? Explain your answer.
- In Luke 18, Jesus tells the rich young ruler he must sell all his possessions, give the money to the poor and follow him in order to have eternal life. Why does Jesus respond to him in this way? What does this tell us about entering into the kingdom of God?

ALTERNATE QUESTIONS:

- What stood out to you as you read through the Bible reading this past week?
- What did your readings reveal to you about who God is and/or how He works?
- Was there anything that challenged or confused you about what you read?
- In what ways did the Word shape your life this week? How did you apply it in your life?
