Written Blessing

Parents should learn to write out a spiritual blessing for their child. Invite family members and other people who have been instrumental in your child's growth and development. Encourage them to also write out a spiritual blessing. Set a date for everyone to come to your home to read/share their blessing and words of encouragement and affirmation to your child. Dad should read his last and then gather around the child for laying on of hands and commissioning prayer.

Blessing for a Son
